## 1. Apply online and pay the fee

- Visit [apply.educationplannerbc.ca](https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca) to apply
- Always use your **official name** (as it appears on your official documents i.e. birth certificate, passport, etc.);
- Pay the application fee.
  - Pay when you apply

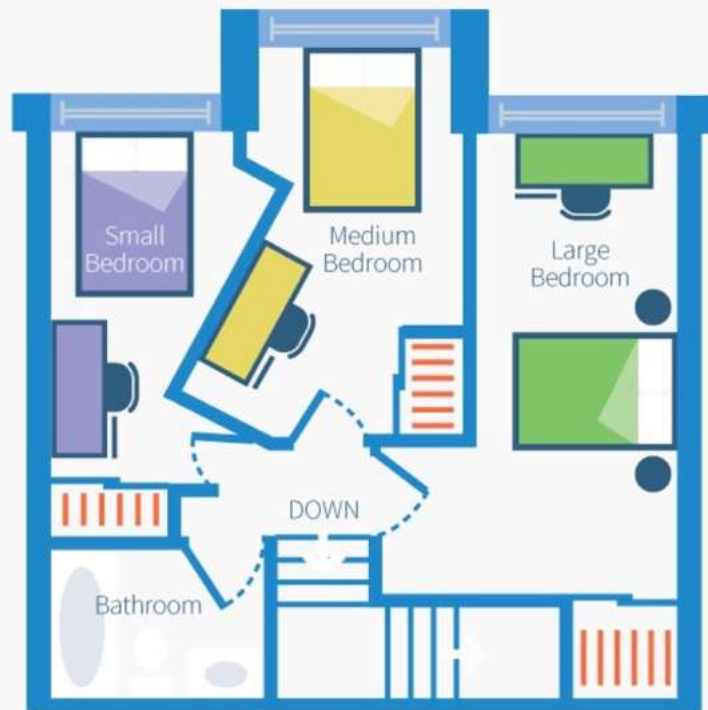

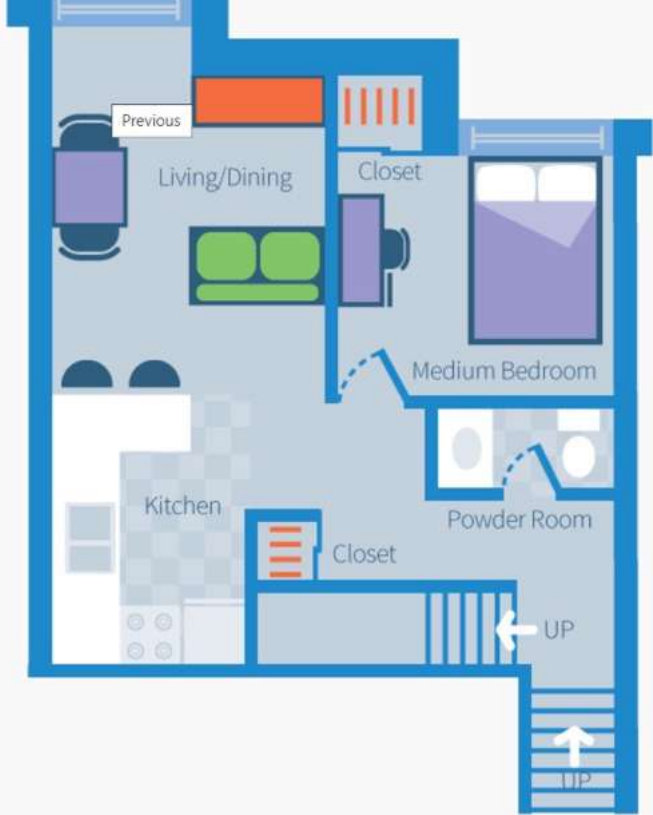

# How to Apply for Housing

- 2024 Summer & Winter Session Housing
- Winter Session Residence—September to April
- Summer Residence— May to August
- **apply** no later than **May 1** and **accept** your offer of admission to UBC once you receive it.
- Should apply **both** Winter and Summer session, otherwise Housing will not provide living place for the gap between
  - w/o winter session, summer session move out – mid Aug
  - w/o summer session, winter session move in – Sep

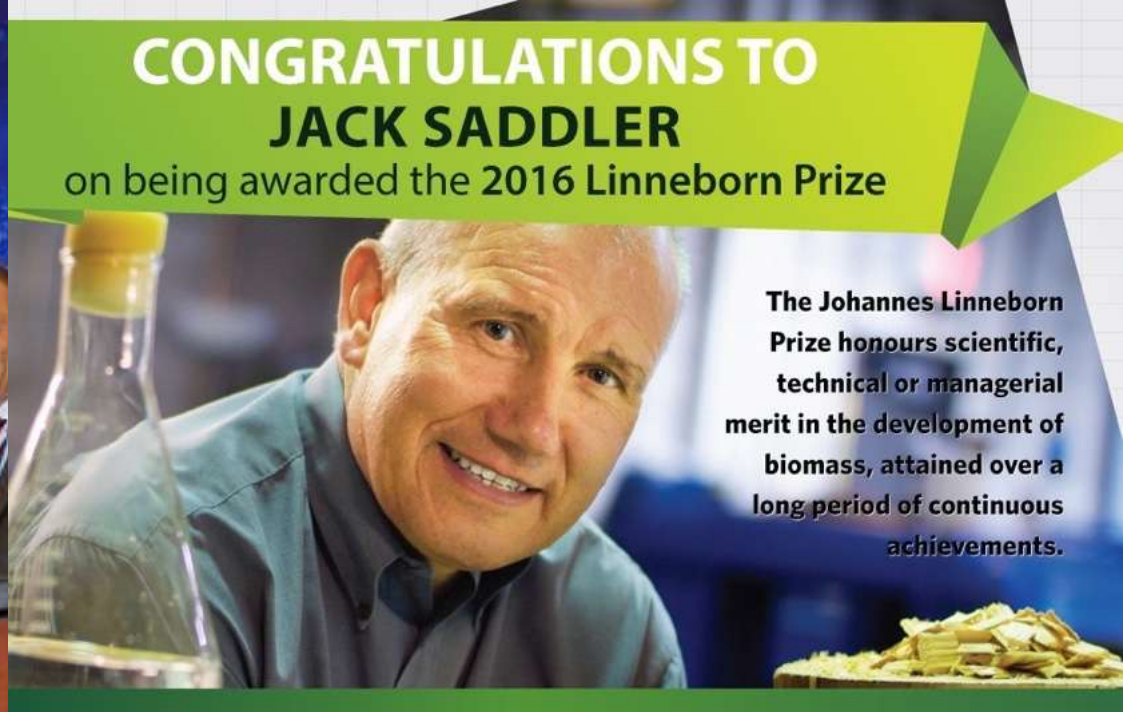

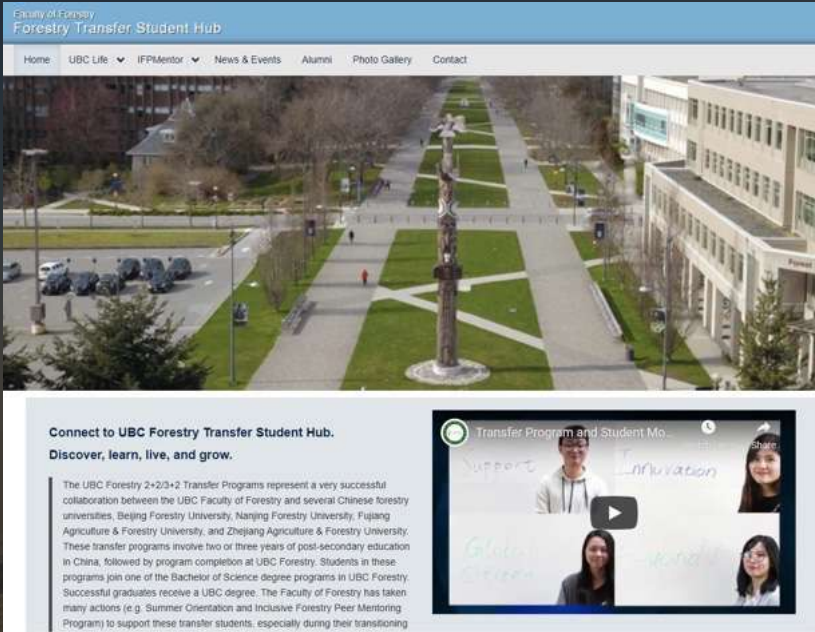
