Language requirements	All courses are taught in English (except for language courses)
	Undergraduate exchange students who wish to take only undergraduate-level courses are not required to submit a TOEFL score if they have a letter from their coordinator or from an English language instructor verifying their level of English language fluency is adequate to successfully complete courses in English.
	Undergraduate students who wish to take one or more graduate courses MUST submit a TOEFL or IELTS score. The score should be at least:
	Official TOEFL Examination – Internet-based score (IBT) of 61 <u>OR</u> Paper-based score (IPT) of 500 or higher <u>OR</u> Official IELTS Examination, Score ≥ 6.0.
	Note: some departments (e.g. English, Communications, Marketing) have higher minimum TOEFL requirements for graduate students.
	Graduate students MUST submit a TOEFL or IELTS score during the application process. The score should be at least:
	Official TOEFL Examination (IBT) of 79 or higher <u>OR</u> Paper-based (IPT) score of 550 or higher <u>OR</u> Official IELTS Examination, Score ≥ 6.5
	These examinations must have been taken within two years of the date of application.

HOUSING

	All unmarried exchange students under the age of 25 live on campus in the "Global Scholars House Living Learning Community, located in the center of campus in IBA Hall. The Global Scholars HOUSE (GSH) includes both U.S. domestic students and international exchange students to provide an opportunity for stronger community involvement and easy friendships while in Stillwater. Rooms are double occupancy (same gender) & are fully furnished. The floors are co-ed, with single gender community bathrooms. There is a common kitchen, lounges, and FREE on-site laundry facilities. 	A dedicated Coordinator (current graduate student) from the Study Abroad Office lives in the hall to facilitate connections between students, help plan activities, and provide support for a successful exchange while studying at OSU.
Distance from housing to University?	GSH is centrally located on campus within a walking distance of 5-7 minutes to most classroom buildings. It is also next to the University Health Services Clinic and across from the Colvin Recreational Center.
Are meals included in housing?	No, but students have the option of purchasing a meal plan if desired
Application deadline for housing	Students have a guaranteed room & once you have been admitted to OSU, you must abide by any withdrawal deadline for housing, even if you have not completed a ResLife housing application! *Students must be admitted and have their OSU email account activated. They must apply online on their own after instructed.
Cost	Student Housing is charged to student's OSU finance account once the semester has begun. Global Scholars House (IBA) Hall is one of the most affordable residency halls! Please see:
