



Dear University Presidents, Dear Ladies and Gentlemen, Dear Friends,



Since the year 2002, the Chinese Studies Center of the University of Salzburg in cooperation with the Eurasia-Pacific Uninet (EPU) has been annually organizing the Chinese-Austrian-EU Summer School for students from the Chinese member institutions. Since asked by the students and our long partner universities in China to bring Paris back into the program, the Chinese Studies Center was able to arrange some modifications to the program that hopefully leads to improvement and fulfilling time for our participants during their European visit.

The 16th Chinese-Austrian-EU Summer School will take place in Salzburg (Austria), Vienna (Austria), Prague (Czech Republic), Heidelberg (Germany), Paris (France), Strasbourg (France), Verona (Italy) and Venice (Italy) from **July 15th to August 12th 2017**. Optional trips to Versailles (France), Neuschwanstein Castle (Germany) and Hallstatt (Austria) are possible if wanted.

The universities are going to be matched in different groups. The decision, who is going to be in which group, will be made when all nominations from all participating universities are in (after the 1st of April).

Requirements and participants

The Chinese-Austrian-EU Summer School is directed towards students who want to deepen their knowledge about Europe in general and Austria in particular.

Since all the lectures are held in English, having a good command of written and spoken English is a basic prerequisite for participation. Responsible contact persons from our member institutions have to make sure that the English language abilities of the selected students are meeting this minimum requirement.

Program and itinerary

The program of the Chinese-Austrian-EU Summer School includes lectures in Salzburg, Vienna, Heidelberg, Paris, Venice and Strasbourg.

Only in case of a severe problem we can make an exception, otherwise the attendance in the official program (includes lectures, daytrips and also the main sightseeing program) is mandatory.

In Salzburg there will be classes on Austrian history, Austrian politics, German literature, Austrian music, Psychology and the philosophical and religious background of European culture. As for sightseeing, we are going to take a trip to the Lake District, to the Hellbrunn Castle, a sightseeing tour through Salzburg, etc.

Flights

Since participants in 2015 suggested it would be easier and more convenient for the students to book their own flights, we have made the decision to have the pilot in 2016 and the students had the possibility to book their own flights. Since the students were really happy to choose their own flights, we will continue this year in the same way.

As every year, we will of course arrange a shuttle bus that picks up the students from the Airport (in Munich, Paris and Vienna – depending on the group they are in). Of course, the European group leaders will be at the Airport with the busses to pick up the students from their European destinations.

Costs

The costs for the summer school amount to 2,900 EUR (without the bank fees and the fees for the optional trips).

This includes accommodation (double rooms/including breakfast), lecture fees, insurance, transportation as well as the costs for the sightseeing trips (except the optional trips).

Single rooms

Accompanying teachers or students, who wish to stay in a single room, may do so under an extra charge. We will inform you about payment procedures after we receive your nomination.

Optional Trips

Hallstatt

A half day trip includes the pick up from the hotel with a private bus and the transfer to Hallstatt. 25.00 € per person

Castle Neuschwanstein

A daytrip includes the pick up from the hotel, the transfer to the Castle and also the entrance fees. 70.00 € per person

The deadline for the payment of the program fees will be the 1st of May 2017. If we don't receive the program fees from a student until the 1st of May 2017, we reserve the right to hand the spot to another student on the waiting list.

We also must inform you about our cancelation fees

If a student decides to drop out after the 1st of May but before the 30th of May, we withhold 25% of the costs. For any drop outs between the 1st and the 30th of June, we will claim 50% of the program costs.

After the 30th of June, we are claiming a 100% cancelation fee.
