The University of Extremadura (UEx) is a Higher Education Institution, which was born in 1973 and is located in the southwest of Spain on the Portuguese border.

The University of Extremadura is a modern institution with more than 20.000 students, more than 2.000 professors and 17 centres (11 faculties, 6 university and engineering schools) and one joined centre- distributed among its four campuses (Badajoz, Cáceres, Mérida and Plasencia: outstanding cities with stunning cultural heritage). In addition, the UEx counts with the Instituto de Lenguas Modernas (ILM) and the Instituto de Español como Lengua Extranjera (IELE).

The academic offer of the UEx encompasses a wide variety of more than 60 grades (EHEA) and masters, which combine lectures with traineeships in enterprises, giving the students a well-rounded education according to the needs of the global and changeable labour market. Moreover, the UEx offers doctorate studies in its International Postgraduate School, research programs, international summer courses and Spanish Language Courses.

Course Schedule

2nd semester: mid-February till first week of July.

Special requirements for STUDY ABROAD_Destin UEx Master Degree
