# Self-assessment: "Am I admissible?"

### Do you have:

- An overall Grade Point Average (GPA) at least 68% (full admission) & 78% (conditional admission) – might differ
  - Your GPA will be calculated on the most recent 30 credits (roughly 1 year courses) you have completed (except for PE lesson);
- Do you satisfy the English Language Admission Standard (ELAS)?



# **English Language Requirement**

UBC accepts different tests of English language proficiency that evaluate skills in listening, reading, speaking and writing. The most commonly submitted are the **Test of English as a Foreign-Language (TOEFL)** and the **International English Language Testing System (IELTS).** 

## TOEFL

- UBC institution code is 0965
- Internet-based test: overall 90/120 minimum part score 21 (writing and speaking) and 22 (reading and Listening)

## IELTS

> Minimum score: an average of **6.5** with **no part less than 6.0** 

Please note that UBC will accept test results taken no more than two years before you apply

# February 15, 2022

- Official Transcripts have to be sent directly by your institution, name the file UBC student number, Last name, First name- Transcript (e.g. 12345678 Han, Meimei – Transcript)
- Course in Progress have to be sent along with your transcript and name the file in the format (e.g. 12345678 Han, Meimei CIP)
- English Proficiency test scores have to be sent directly by the testing agency (IELTS file name: e.g. 12345678 Han, Meimei IELTS)

### When:

You will have to accept the UBC offer through the Student Service Centre (Deadline: May 1, 2022 – check your SSC: <u>https://ssc.adm.ubc.ca/sscportal/</u>) and pay the registration deposit then you will receive an email from UBC telling you on what day and at what time you will be able to register.

### Which courses should you register in:

Within the articulated program: The program manager (Ms. Joris Jun) will send your specific program sheet before course registration.

**Outside of the articulated program:** You should send Joris, all of the courses that you have completed with a course syllabus of what the course covered and on of them, together with academic advisors: <u>https://forestry.ubc.ca/students/undergraduate-student-</u>portal/undergraduate-student-services/, and program director, will work on your UBC study plan
