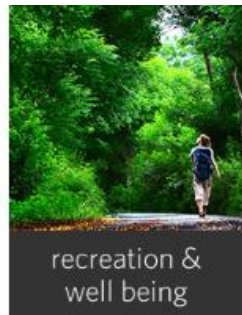

How to Apply for Housing

- 2022 Summer & Winter Session Housing
- Winter Session Residence—September to April
- Summer Residence— May to August
- **apply** no later than **May 1** and **accept** your offer of admission to UBC once you receive it.
- Should apply **both** Winter and Summer session, otherwise Housing will not provide living place for the gap between
 - w/o winter session, summer session move out – mid Aug
 - w/o summer session, winter session move in – Sep



Self-assessment: “Am I admissible?”

Do you have:

- An overall Grade Point Average (GPA) at least 68% (full admission) & 78% (conditional admission) – might differ
 - Your GPA will be calculated on the most recent 30 credits (roughly 1 year courses) you have completed (**except for PE lesson**);
- Do you satisfy the English Language Admission Standard (ELAS)?



English Language Requirement

UBC accepts different tests of English language proficiency that evaluate skills in listening, reading, speaking and writing. The most commonly submitted are the **Test of English as a Foreign-Language (TOEFL)** and the **International English Language Testing System (IELTS)**.

TOEFL

- UBC institution code is **0965**
- Internet-based test: overall **90/120**
minimum part score **21 (writing and speaking)** and **22 (reading and Listening)**

IELTS

- Minimum score: an average of **6.5** with **no part less than 6.0**

Please note that UBC will accept test results taken no more than two years before you apply

When is the document deadline?

International students: Deadline to submit your required documents to UBC. Deadline to submit documents in support of meeting the English Language Admission Standard (ELAS).

February 15, 2022

- **Official Transcripts** have to be sent directly by your institution, name the file UBC student number, Last name, First name– Transcript (e.g. 12345678 Han, Meimei – Transcript)
- **Course in Progress** have to be sent along with your transcript and name the file in the format (e.g. 12345678 Han, Meimei – CIP)
- **English Proficiency test scores** have to be sent directly by the testing agency (IELTS file name: e.g. 12345678 Han, Meimei – IELTS)

When:

You will have to accept the UBC offer through the Student Service Centre (Deadline: May 1, 2022 – check your SSC: <https://ssc.adm.ubc.ca/sscportal/>) and pay the registration deposit then you will receive an email from UBC telling you on what day and at what time you will be able to register.

Which courses should you register in:

Within the articulated program: The program manager (Ms. Joris Jun) will send your specific program sheet before course registration.

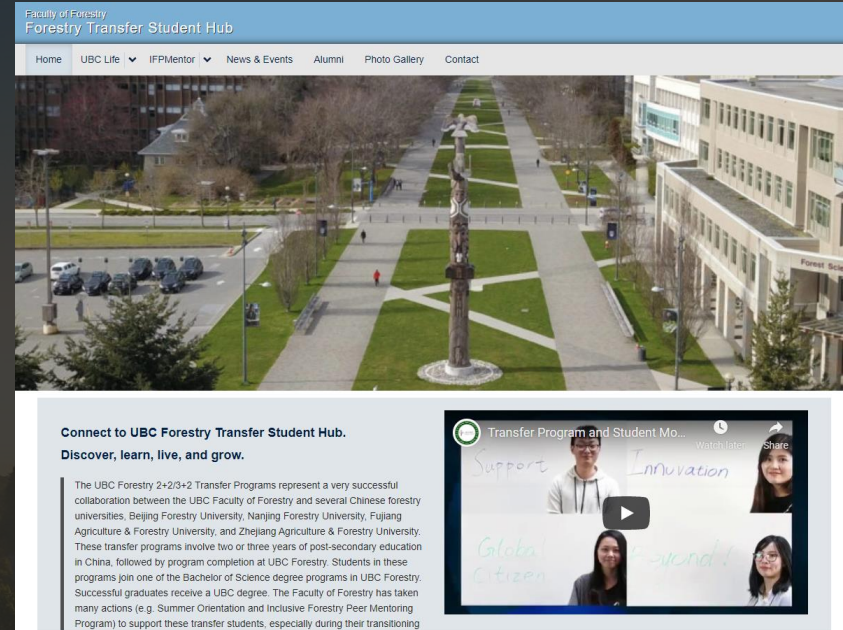
