	All unmarried exchange students under the age of 25 live on campus in the <u>"Global Scholars House</u> <u>Living Learning Community</u> , located in the center of campus in IBA Hall. The Global Scholars HOUSE (GSH) includes both U.S. domestic students and international exchange students to provide an opportunity for stronger community involvement and easy friendships while in Stillwater. Rooms are double occupancy (same gender) & are fully furnished. The floors are co-ed, with single gender community bathrooms. There is a common kitchen, lounges, and FREE on-site laundry facilities.
