Forest Operations Major

- Planning and implementing complex harvesting
- Operations that maximize economic returns and minimize environmental impact
- Minor in Commerce available
- Students can apply to become Registered Professional Foresters or Professional Engineer







- Focus: Scientific principles related to the growth and development of forest organisms, and the ecology of plant and animal communities.
- Students select an area of concentration during their second year
 - Genetics, ecology, entomology, pathology, silviculture, and fire science.
 - International Specialization: forest ecosystems in another part of the world.

Science and Management Major

- Conservation and management of renewable natural resources, and landscape and local level planning for both terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems.
- Integrated Conservation Field School; semester-long (4th yr.) course divided into modules, each concentrating on a particular component of B.C.'s environment

New UBC student residence to be among world's tallest wood buildings

One of the tallest wood buildings in the world will soon be constructed at UBC, providing housing for hundreds of students. When completed, the \$51.5-million residence building will stand 53 metres tall (about 174 feet).

"This beautiful, new tall wood building will serve as a living laboratory for the UBC community," said Martha Piper, interim president. "It will advance the university's reputation as a hub of sustainable and innovative design, and provide our students with much-needed on-campus housing."

Construction of the 18-storey tall wood student residence will begin later this fall, and the building is set to open in September 2017. It will house 404 students in 272 studios and 33 four-bedroom units, and feature study and social gathering spaces. There will also be a ground-floor lounge and study space for commuter students.

"This project shows that when it comes to building with wood, B.C.'s innovation can't be beat," said Steve Thomson, minister of Forests, Lands and Natural Resource Operations. "By taking advantage of new building technologies, we're also expanding our markets for B.C. wood products – and supporting jobs in the forest sector."

In addition to its primary function as a student residence, the building will serve as an academic site for students and

The UBC Forestry 2+2/3+2 Transfer Programs represent a very successful collaboration between the UBC Faculty of Forestry and several Chinese forestry universities, Beijing Forestry University, Nanjing Forestry University, Fujiang Apriculture & Forestry University, and Zhejiang Apriculture & Forestry University. These transfer programs involve two or three years of post-secondary education in China, followed by program completion at UBC Forestry. Students in these programs join one of the Bachelor of Science degree programs in UBC Forestry Successful graduates receive a UBC degree.
